In 2026, we launched a Sunday School program. Every Sunday, when we excuse them from the sanctuary to go to their respective classes, they nearly always need to be reminded not to run because of their excitement. For those who teach Sunday School, imagine a class with you and one other teacher teaching 50+ children from the community. Pray for our few teachers!

Early last year, I began to feel a burden for the city of Cape Town. Mid-year, a man reached out who had attended a doctrinal conference in Zimbabwe nearly 10 years prior. He is now located in Cape Town and requested that we come and host a conference there. The response was phenomenal, and we have a new group of leaders who are already progressing nicely through our online Bible School.

Lastly, we have two new mission projects for 2026. First, we have 4 people sharing 1 mission vehicle. We are trusting that God will make a way for us to purchase a second vehicle soon. The cost for a reliable used vehicle will be +\$35,000. Secondly, our mission house needs a water filtration system to make our well water potable. This system can be purchased locally for +\$5,000. Please prayerfully consider joining with us to make these needs possible.
